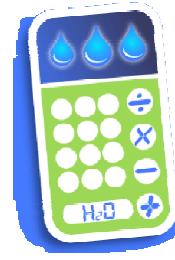


Drive to 65

Water Use Converter



Use this easy formula to determine if your household is meeting the state guideline for water usage, which cannot exceed 65 gallons per day per person.

On your water bill, usage is listed in cubic feet. You need to convert cubic feet to gallons and then divide by the number of people in your household to see if you are meeting the guideline.



1. # of cubic feet per day x 7.48 = # of gallons per day
2. # of gallons per day / # of people = # of gallons per day per person (pdpp)

For example:

25 cubic feet per day x 7.48 = 187 gallons per day

187 gallons per day / 3 persons in household = 62.3 gallons pdpp
