Protruding nails or staples can tear line workers' protective clothing or gloves, increasing the chance of injury. Boots or climbing spikes may also get caught, causing a fall. We believe that our "no signs" policy makes sense from an aesthetic perspective as well. Eyesores to begin with, the poles are not improved upon with the addition of flyers, signs and other debris. Please keep our workers safe and our town attractive by refraining from posting notices on our poles.
