

Littleton Clean Lakes Committee (LCLC) Meeting Minutes

Minutes of the 7:00PM, October 4th, 2005 meeting

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jon Folsom at the Operations Center at 39 Ayer Road, Littleton, Massachusetts.

Attendees: Jon Folsom, Dan Lord, Chuck Bush, Steve Sussman, Savas Danos and Leon Weaver.

Committee minutes from our July 19th and August 2nd meetings were reviewed and unanimously accepted by attendees.

Savas summarized the latest work on the Village on the Common effort and the possible implications of this effort.

Mill Pond

ESS recently contacted Savas. A review of the final ACE report should be happening soon. This is a gate to permitting, which should be done next year.

Spectacle Pond

The treatments in July seem to be having the desired effect. Both the Fanwort and Milfoil appear to be significantly beat back. There is some Fanwort that appears to have been "hit" but not completed killed off. In some locations, sparse new growth has appeared although it doesn't look very robust. We'll compare notes with Lee Lyman of Lycott to determine if this is as expected. The real test of the effectiveness of these treatments will most likely be determined by the growth these non-native invasive species, or the lack thereof, next spring/summer. A representative from Lycott will be attending the Spectacle Pond Association fall meeting on the 19th of October to summarize the work done thus far.

Long Lake

Savas showed us a CD which includes a segment on the Low Impact Development (LID) work being done on the lake ("Reigning in the Storm, One Building at a Time – An introduction to Low Impact Development").

The LLNA did some Purple Loosestrife harvesting (about a truck-load was hauled away).

Savas mentioned the forebay and splitter are probably due for a clean-out.
