Spectacle Pond:

The up-coming Conservation Committee meeting is to review the revised Order of Conditions. If approval is received, the herbicide treatment could begin in May.

Savas has met with Ayer and a consortium, led by Ayer, may be formulated to review the purchase of the Guilford property.

Long Lake:

Rain Garden locations are to be reviewed at the March meeting.

The boat launch project was reviewed with discussion re-working the drainage system as it approaches the rain gardens and shifting the rain gardens 1' - 5' to the northwest to save trees. The project is expected to be complete in the spring of '05.

Aquatic Control's proposal was discussed with generally positive feedback. Savas will solicit additional detail on timing and scope.
