

Minutes of the Littleton Clean Lakes Committee Meeting  
Tuesday, July 19, 2005

The Committee convened at the Operations Center at 7:10 PM

CLC Members present: Jon Folsom, Dan Lord, Steven Sussman, and Leon Weaver. (Savas Danos attended a meeting of the Nashoba Chamber of Commerce that evening)

The minutes for the meeting on June 14, 2005 were approved.

### **Long Lake**

Chemical treatment by Aquatic Control Systems has been effective in eliminating weeds in the beach area.

Kiosks with preliminary displays are installed at the park and the boat ramp. Additional information will be added later.

The upstream basin of the Wetlands Park is scheduled for cleaning.

Dan Lord reported that flowers planted in the Wetlands Park by Long Lake residents have been stolen.

A homeowner has removed erosion control plantings installed by the town.

The Long Lake Association plans to purchase benches for installation in the Wetland Park and along the shoreline.

Jon Folsom read Ruddy Ham's written comments on the boat ramp construction. Ruddy offered stone curbing (excluding trucking fee) for use on the Long Lake project.

High water conditions have damaged the berm along the lakeshore.

Rain garden installation will begin shortly.

### **Spectacle Pond**

Leon Weaver showed pictures of chemical treatment by Lycott Environmental. Pellets were released on July 5 and July 14. The targeted weed fanwort turned from green to white in about 12 days.

### **Mill Pond**

Peter Cassinari dropped off a copy of an application by Veryfine Products Inc. for a discharge permit into Reedy Meadow Brook, which runs into Mill Pond. Steve Sussman will bring the application to the attention of Debbie Bray, President of the Mill Pond Association.

No word yet from the US Army Corps of Engineer regarding the overdue report.
