

Littleton Clean Lakes Committee (LCLC) Meeting Minutes

Minutes of the 7:00PM, April 21st, 2009 meeting

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jon Folsom at the Operations Center at 39 Ayer Road, Littleton, Massachusetts.

Attendees: Jon Folsom, Dan Lord, Savas Danos, Steve Sussman and Leon Weaver.

Minutes from our March 10th, 2009 meeting were read and unanimously approved by the membership without modification.

Rain barrel distribution day is set for Saturday, May 16th, 2009. LWD, in conjunction with LCLC, will distribute rain barrels from 9AM to 12PM. The committee unanimously approved acquisition of \$5,000 of "Pearl's Premium Ultra Low Maintenance Grass Seed". LWD and LCLC are sponsoring a sale of this seed. Long Lake

The committee reviewed ACT's proposal for weeds mitigation work this year. Their bid for fanwort treatment alone for 2009 was well over the \$20,000 threshold that triggers re-opening of the RFP process (\$47,900). Savas will send out a RFP as soon as possible as we'll want to select a vendor quickly because we typically need to have pond surveys done in May with early treatments in June.

Spectacle Pond

The committee reviewed Lycott's proposal for weeds mitigation work this year. The bid for Spectacle Pond treatment of fanwort and milfoil treatment was over the \$20,000 threshold (\$24,280) thus re-opening the RFP process for this work as well.

Very light beaver activity this year most likely due to the trapping that was done in the fall by Beaver Solutions.
