Mandatory Water Conservation in Effect

Due to lower than average rainfall in recent weeks, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection is requiring the Littleton Water Department to enforce a temporary, but mandatory water conservation program effective immediately. Please note that outdoor water use is prohibited between the hours of 9AM and 5PM until further notice. This includes irrigation of lawns via sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems, washing of vehicles except in a commercial car wash, and washing of any exterior building or landscape surfaces. Intentional violation of this mandatory water conservation program may result in fines of up to \$400.

We appreciate your compliance with this program, designed to ensure a sustainable drinking water supply while also protecting natural resources and streamflow for aquatic life. If you are not already enrolled in our Community Notification System, please take a moment to enroll on our website now to ensure you receive the latest information on water use restrictions, water main breaks, power outages, and other emergency situations. You will receive notification via this automated system when the temporary state of water supply conservation has ended.
