



Environmental Engineering Intern – Water Department

The Littleton Water Department (LWD) will be hiring a temporary summer intern to assist with water quality monitoring and the operation, maintenance, and mapping of Littleton's water infrastructure. This position will work under the Water Systems Manager and the Environmental Analyst.

Tasks to be performed include:

- Groundwater Monitoring – Conduct water quality sampling and water level monitoring field work at approximately 50 groundwater monitoring wells located on commercial properties in the Town of Littleton.
- Water System Mapping – Scan, georeference, and digitize hard copies of water main as-built drawings into LWD's Geographic Information System (GIS). May conduct GPS field data collection as well.
- Operations & Maintenance – Assist licensed water operators with routine operation & maintenance of water treatment plants, production wells, and distribution infrastructure. This will include assisting with maintenance & operation of specialized equipment (after receiving training), as well as independently conducting non-specialized maintenance activities, such as painting fire hydrants or water tanks, greasing hydrant caps, installing hydrant flags, etc.

The position requires a valid Class D Massachusetts Driver's license, enrollment in a related undergraduate degree program, and proficiency with ArcGIS software.
