

Smart Home Improvement Credit

Eligibility: This program is for **residential electric heating** customers who make energy-efficient home improvements recommended by a completed home energy audit.

Customers in Littleton Electric Light Department (LELD) service area are eligible for rebates subject to the availability of funds from LELD. LELD reserves the right to change any portion of this program or end this program at any time without notice.

What is considered a Smart Home Improvement?: Smart Home Improvement projects include

- Adding insulation to the attic, basement, rim joist, walls and pipes
- Weather stripping windows and doors
- Replacing exterior doors, storm doors, and storm windows with energy efficient models
- Installing energy efficient heating and cooling systems

Need an Energy Audit?: All improvement projects must be installed after an energy audit. Call ENE at (888) 772-4242 or visit www.lelwd.com/greenrewards/ to schedule your free home energy audit.

Rebate amounts and payments: Credit will equal 20% of the cost of the project, yet not to exceed \$300 a year. Applications will be processed as they are received. Please allow 4 to 6 weeks for the rebate in the form of a check.

Verification: A copy of the energy audit report and original sales receipt indicating the type of project, materials, price, and date must accompany the rebate application. Home improvement projects must reflect the recommendations outlined in the audit report. LELD reserves the right to inspect the completed project and to request documentation of having electric heat. **Incomplete applications will be returned.**
