Construction of a new water tank on Cedar Hill Road, adjacent to the existing tank, will start on or after June 7th. The 14-month project may impact traffic in the area and result in daytime construction noise. Residents in the area of Cedar Hill please note:

- **Schedule:** Construction can be expected between 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. Work will begin with the construction of a foundation in June and a pedestal in July. Delivery of a prefabricated steel tank is scheduled for November.
- **Traffic:** Drivers in the area may see increased traffic from construction vehicles. Traffic detours may be necessary to transport large equipment and materials to the worksite. Detours will be marked and police details used as necessary to ensure safety.
- **Updates:** LELWD plans to use the Community Notification System and other methods to contact impacted residents as necessary.

WATER TANK CONSTRUCTION ON CEDAR HILL ROAD STARTS IN JUNE

The new storage tank will be constructed adjacent to the existing water tank at 34 Cedar Road.

- The existing water storage tank was constructed in 1950 and holds approximately 485,000 gallons of water.
- The new tank design will be a composite concrete pedestal and steel tank with similar volume as the current tank.
- The existing Cedar Hill Tank is critical to LWD's ability to meet the daily demand of our customers, as well as maintain proper pressure in the Long Lake neighborhood.
- Once the new storage tank is in service, the existing tank will be removed and the site restored.
