Dear Neighbors,

The construction of a new Cedar Hill water tank has proceeded this summer and fall with completion of the cement pedestal as planned. Starting in early December, work will begin on constructing the metal water tank to sit atop the pedestal.

The 500,000-gallon tank will be brought to the site in pieces for assembly. It is too large to assemble offsite and move in one piece to Cedar Hill. The contractor advises LELWD that the assembly process will create intermittent, loud noises. The assembly process will be completed in January.

After assembly, the tank will be painted this spring and then hoisted onto the cement pedestal. When the new tank is fully operational, the old tank will be removed. We expect the project to be completed in the fall of next year.

The replacement of the Cedar Hill water tank is an important piece of maintaining the town's safe and reliable public water supply. The tank ensures adequate storage and water pressure for a large portion of our community.

We wish to apologize in advance for any disturbance and thank you for your continued understanding and patience. We hope that scheduling the tank assembly for the winter months, when windows are typically closed, will decrease the impact.
