



Water Resource Intern

The Littleton Water Department (LWD) will be hiring a temporary summer intern to assist with water quality monitoring and evaluation, and the analysis of Littleton's water and sewer system infrastructure. This position will work under the Environmental Manager.

Depending on the successful applicant's skills and interests, responsibilities may include:

- Water Resource Monitoring – Conduct water quality sampling and water level monitoring field work at approximately 50 groundwater monitoring wells and 4 surface water sites located throughout the Town of Littleton.
- Water Quality Testing and Data Analysis – Test drinking water for mineral content, enter and organize water quality data for temporal analyses, assist with monthly and quarterly water sampling.
- Geographic Information Systems – Participate in the development of online maps and collection of geographic feature information to create a comprehensive, up-to-date spatial database of Littleton's water distribution systems.
- Quality Control and Assurance – Aid in the development, organization, and maintenance of various systems that allow Littleton's water and sewer operations to function as efficiently and effectively as possible.

The position requires a valid Class D Massachusetts Driver's license, enrollment in a related undergraduate degree program, some knowledge of GIS, and proficiency with Microsoft Excel.
