



## Treatment Systems Operator

Due to a recent retirement, the Littleton Water Department is accepting applications for the position of Treatment Systems Operator through June 2<sup>nd</sup>, or until such time the position is filled. The successful applicant will operate and maintain all equipment at our two water treatment plants, one wastewater treatment plant, and will assist in the maintenance and construction of the drinking water distribution and wastewater collection systems. This is an exciting time to join LELWD to further your career in water and wastewater treatment, as we have a new water treatment plant coming online this month that uses biological filtration to remove iron and manganese, as well as granular activated carbon filtration to remove PFAS. We also have a traditional GreenSandPlus filtration plant that is only 9 years old. In addition, construction of a new membrane bioreactor plant for wastewater treatment and a new collection system for the Littleton Common are beginning in June.

This is a union position with a **base salary between \$82,700 and \$91,800** per year after accounting for all stipends and standby pay. Overtime pay is in addition. Applicants should have a minimum of 3 years' experience in the water and/or wastewater treatment field. The position also requires the prospective candidate to possess a minimum of a T1 & D1 Drinking Water Operators License.

Benefits include a four-day work week (10-hour days, Monday through Thursday), enrollment in the Massachusetts Public Pension System, 12 paid holidays per year, 2 weeks' vacation per year, 12 sick days per year, and 24 hours of personal time per year. After a reasonable training period, the successful candidate will be required to participate in the weekly on-call rotation, which requires the ability to respond to after-hours emergencies at any time of day or night for one week out of every six.
