Re: LELWD Water Main Extension into Boxborough

Dear Resident,

I am writing to provide you with an update on the Water Main Extension project that will extend LELWD's water distribution system into the Town of Boxborough to bring clean water to homes and businesses with polluted wells at no cost to Littleton ratepayers.

Construction began on Whitcomb Ave at Nancy's Way on Monday, December 2, and will continue Monday through Friday until December 20th. The construction will move from this location, onto Littleton County Rd continuing toward the Littleton-Harvard town boundary. LELWD's contractor hopes to complete this section by the end of the year, and will start construction on Beaver Brook Rd in Boxborough in Spring of 2025. The project will continue down Beaver Brook Rd, onto Swanson Rd, and end on Codman Hill Rd. The approximate end date of the project is Fall 2026.

LELWD has worked closely with the Police Departments from Littleton and Harvard to implement a traffic plan that minimizes the inconvenience to residents and commuters in this area, while maximizing the efficiency of work on the project. The majority of vehicular and truck traffic will be detoured to Old Littleton Rd and Oak Hill Rd, while local passenger and school bus traffic will be allowed through as needed.

A public forum will be held in January that will allow for a more detailed update on the project and this will be open for public comment. More updates will be available on our website throughout the duration of the project.
