



Water Main Construction on Whitcomb Avenue from Taylor Street to the Route 2 Overpass

- *Starting January 6, 2025, Expect Detours for Thru Traffic*
- *Local Traffic & School Buses Allowed*

The Project: A new drinking water well on Taylor Street requires installation of a raw water main to connect to the Whitcomb Avenue Water Treatment Plant. The main will run under Whitcomb Avenue, traveling in a southerly direction from Taylor Street to the Route 2 overpass. There, the main will turn off-road and run adjacent to Route 2 East. While the road is trenched, a new, finished water main will also be installed to replace the existing main serving Whitcomb Ave. properties.

What to Expect:

- The water main work is scheduled to begin January 6 & the work on Whitcomb Avenue is expected to take up to 2 months to complete.
- LELWD is working with the Littleton Police Department and the contractor, C. Naughton Corp., to implement a traffic plan to minimize the inconvenience to residents and commuters while maintaining a safe and efficient work zone. Please follow detour signs and the directions of police details.
- Local passenger and school bus traffic will be allowed through as needed. Local traffic should stop and ask the detail officer for assistance in safely passing through the work zone.
- Thru traffic should expect to be detoured onto Porter Road while the work proceeds on Whitcomb Ave. between Taylor Street and Porter Road. Thru traffic should expect to be detoured to Oak Hill Road and Old Littleton Road when the work advances to the section between Porter Road and the Route 2 overpass.
