

INVITATION FOR BIDS

LITTLETON ELECTRIC LIGHT AND WATER DEPARTMENTS INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB)

The Littleton Water Department (“LWD”) invites bids from qualified bidders for: the redevelopment of LWD Wells (well 1, 2-1, 2-2, 2-3, 3-1, 3-2, 3-3, 3-4 and 5), located in Littleton, MA 01460. Each well is described in the scope of work.

Specifications, instructions to bidders and related bid documents may be obtained electronically beginning on November 6th, 2025 from the Littleton Electric Light and Water Department’s website, lelwd.com.

Prospective bidders must complete a one-time registration process on the website in order to download bid documents. In addition, questions, or clarifications regarding this IFB should be submitted in writing to: info@lelwd.com attn. Paul Denaro, Littleton Water Department.

All bids for this project are subject to the applicable provisions of the Massachusetts bidding laws, including those found at M.G.L. c. 149, §§ 44A – 44H and M.G.L. c. 30, § 39M et seq.

A bid deposit in an amount equal to 5% of the total amount of the bid will be due with the bid, in the form of a certified check, bid bond or cashier’s check. The bidder agrees that its bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 days, Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of the bids.

A payment bond in an amount equal to 50% of the total amount of the bid, with a surety company qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, will be required for the successful bidder.

Attention is directed to the minimum wage rates to be paid on this project as determined by the Department of Labor Standards under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 149, §§ 26-27D.

All bids must be sealed and marked on the outside “IFB 2025 Well Redevelopment” and be received at the office of LWD, Nick Lawler, 39 Ayer Rd. Littleton MA 01460, no later than 2:00 p.m. on November 25th, 2025, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

LWD reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities and minor irregularities in bids received, if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the LWD to do so.
